- Welcoming New Talent to Millet

Let us introduce you to Jim Wood. He is a Millet-based Airbrush Artist with 18 years of airbrushing experience. He has a home-based studio where he does most of his work. Jim was born in Paisley, Scotland and moved to Canada in the '70's, where he lived in Lachine, Montreal for 3 years and then finally settled in Wallaceburg, Ontario. Growing up, he always had a passion for art and was often caught doodling cartoons while in class until

one day his teacher told him that he should take an art class. That was his "light bulb" moment. He was always amazed by the custom art he had seen as a teenager in the 70's that artists had painted on the sides of vans. That is when he got interested in airbrushing. He continued to draw and paint and later in life once he was married with children, he and his family moved to Alabama for his job as a Tool and Die Engineer. It was there that he purchased his first air brush! He spent 11 years in Alabama and studied the art of airbrushing in his spare time and taught himself how. At that time, he was able to open his business, Woody's Airbrushing.
